Pastor Paul's Newsletter 11-30-25 Jesus and His Church Working Together

When Jesus was on the earth, He was always functioning in the perfect will of His Father. Jesus never did anything that was not in harmony with His Father, because He found the Scriptures in the Old Testament that pertained unto Himself; and then He did them. The born-again Church is the representative of Jesus now on the earth. Jesus is coming back really soon, so we must be about our Father God's business. How do we do that? Well it's really simple. We find the Scriptures in the New Testament that speak to us as believers; start agreeing with them, and then start doing them - with the help of the Holy Spirit. Let's look at some Scriptures that we, the born-again Church, are commissioned to do.

Acts 10:38 KJV How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: Who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him.

Mark 16:15-20 KJV And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. [16] He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. [17] And these signs shall

follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; [18] They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. [19] So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, He was received up into Heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. [20] And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the Word with signs following. Amen.

Mark 11:22-24 KJV And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. [23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. [24] Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Acts 1:5-8 KJV For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence. [6] When they therefore were come together, they asked of Him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel? [7] And He said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in His own power. [8] But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be

witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Acts 2:17-21 KJV And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of My Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: [18] And on My servants and on My handmaidens I will pour out in those days of My Spirit; and they shall prophesy: [19] And I will shew wonders in Heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: [20] The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come: [21] And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the Name of the Lord shall be saved.

Acts 3:1-8 KJV Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour. [2] And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple; [3] Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms. [4] And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us. [5] And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them. [6] Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up

and walk. [7] And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. [8] And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.

As we get closer to Jesus' return, God wants the Church to minister to people like He did while He was on the earth. So how does this happen? It happens when the Church is filled with the Holy Ghost and allows His power to flow through them. The world needs to be saved, healed, and delivered. When we, the Church, agree with, and do, the Scriptures, the Holy Ghost will perform those Scriptures through us.

I will close this Newsletter with these thoughts. Jesus lived on the earth for 30 years, and there are no recorded miraculous things that He did. Then, when He went down and was baptized by John the Baptist, the Holy Ghost came on Him; and then He did so many miraculous things that the Bible says there's not even enough books in the world to contain them. In 3 1/2 years Jesus showed the world His Father and His power to bring help and healing to a hurting world. Then after Jesus' death and resurrection, He told the Church to 'go wait in Jerusalem till you receive power from on high'; then He told them to go to all the world and do the same works that Jesus did. We, the Church, are to finish what Jesus started.

Matthew 24:14 KJV And this Gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

We will finish what Jesus started! Praise the Lord!
