Mark 5:25-34 KJV And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years, [26] And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse, [27] When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched His garment. [28] For she said, If I may touch but His clothes, I shall be whole. [29] And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague. [30] And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that virtue had gone out of Him, turned Him about in the press, and said, Who touched My clothes? [31] And His disciples said unto Him, Thou seest the multitude thronging Thee, and sayest Thou, Who touched Me? [32] And He looked round about to see her that had done this thing. [33] But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before Him, and told Him all the truth. [34] And He said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

God wants to do great things for you, but He requires you to believe and speak what is in the Bible; then He will bring to pass what you have spoken.

Mark 11:22-23 KJV And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. [23] For verily I say unto you, That

whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

James 3:2-6 KJV For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body. [3] Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body. [4] Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth. [5] Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth! [6] And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.
