**Instead of Just Reading the Bible, Let's Visualize It**

When we are reading the Bible, we must receive the help of the Holy Ghost to reveal to us what we are reading.

John 16:13-15 KJV Howbeit when He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will shew you things to come. [14] He shall glorify Me: for He shall receive of Mine, and shall shew it unto you. [15] All things that the Father hath are Mine: therefore said I, that He shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

God the Father sent Jesus to the earth to die for our sins so that we wouldn't go to hell and be punished forever. But, He also sent Jesus to educate us spiritually through the Holy Ghost. We are baby Christians, when we first receive our spiritual new birth. After that, we must grow so that we can live out our new spiritual life in Christ. The way Christians grow is through understanding what God understands. Our Father God has written us a text book called the Bible so that we can learn and grow. In today's Newsletter, I want to tell you some simple things that will cause you to be able to have a wonderful spiritual life.

We must understand what God understands. When you read the Bible, don't just read words and move on to another reading. Visualize what you are reading. Use your imagination with the Holy Ghost's help, and He will give you revelation so that you can understand what you're reading.

Let's look at some more Scriptures, and let the Holy Ghost give you understanding.

1 Corinthians 2:12-14 KJV Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. [13] Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. [14] But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

In these verses we see that God, the Holy Ghost, wants to teach us so that we can know what God knows. When I'm reading the Bible, I stop and ask the Holy Ghost to reveal to me what the Bible is saying. It's so awesome to get this understanding coming up from my spirit into my mind. Scripture verses will get you to a level in spiritual maturity that the devil will have a hard time winning against you.

As I close, I want to show you how to become a spiritual giant in the Lord. When you are listening to someone that you know is speaking for the Lord, get the Scripture verse that they are preaching or teaching from and study them personally until you can start understanding what they mean. Use the teachers' understanding until you get your own. The reason we want to do this is so we can work the works of God. We are His workers, or employees, on the earth. Our Father God wants us to get mankind saved, and then He wants to teach His children so they can grow up spiritually.
