Mark 16:15-16 KJV And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. [16] He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Romans 10:8-15 KJV But what saith it? The Word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; [9] That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. [10] For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. [11] For the Scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on Him shall not be ashamed. [12] For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the

same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon Him. [13] For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved. [14] How then shall they call on Him in Whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in Him of Whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? [15] And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 KJV Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. [18] And all things are of God, Who hath reconciled us to Himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; [19] To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. [20] Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. [21] For He hath made Him to be sin for us, Who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.

In all of these Scripture verses, we see that those who have been saved and born again can share the Good News with the unsaved. He (God) called us to be ambassadors for Christ. We are to go and just inform people we see that what Jesus did on the cross was to pay for mankind's sins. We must let them know that all of their sins came on Jesus when He was on the cross, and if they receive Jesus, they will have their sins blotted out as

far as the east is from the west; because God loves them. That's why He sent His Son to pay for their sins.
