# The Christian Center Pastor Paul's Newsletter 8-3-25 Learning How to Receive God's Flow

God wants us to know that He has made many things in the earth to flow. We also know that the things He made in the natural world came out of His spiritual world. Therefore, if things flow in this natural world, we know that things flow in the spiritual world. So, let's get into this Newsletter and receive revelation that will give us the ability to receive more from our heavenly Father.

Let's think about something that flows in this natural world: Water. It flows through rivers and streams, and it always flows down hill. Mankind has learned to create flows of water in the same way by understanding that he can make a pipe, or a canal, and adjust the elevation to cause gravity to make the water or fluid flow. Man has also learned that they can cause liquids to flow by creating pressure through the use of pumps that push the liquid into a flow. Now man learned this concept by studying the human body. The natural heart in man and animals push blood to all parts of the body, so life is flowing through the blood. Therefore, mankind has invented machines out of their studies of how God made the natural bodies of man and animals.

Numbers 14:6-8 KJV And Joshua the son of Nun, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, which were of them that searched the

land, rent their clothes: [7] And they spake unto all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land. [8] If the LORD delight in us, then He will bring us into this land, and give it us; a land which floweth with milk and honey.

God was trying to get His people Israel to go into the good land that flowed with milk and honey, but they were afraid to enter into God's flow. Although that land was flowing with God's goodness, the fear that the devil put into the hearts of the people was stopping God's covenant people from receiving the flow of His good news. Let's look at more Scriptures that bear this out.

John 7:37-39 KJV In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto Me, and drink. [38] He that believeth on Me, as the Scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. [39] (But this spake He of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified).

Acts 2:14-21 KJV But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words: [15] For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day. [16] But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; [17] And it shall

come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of My Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: [18] And on My servants and on My handmaidens I will pour out in those days of My Spirit; and they shall prophesy: [19] And I will shew wonders in Heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: [20] The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come: [21] And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the Name of the Lord shall be saved.

In these Scriptures, we see God pouring out of His Spirit; and men prophesied and signs and wonders started manifesting by the Holy Spirit. Now when God pours out, there is the flowing of God's Spirit into us. Hallelujah! Hallelujah!!!

Now remember that when God pours out His Spirit, it's not subject to gravity. The Holy Spirit lives in us, and He can pour His Spirit out of us.

Today as I close this Newsletter, I want to emphasize that God flowing through us comes through our belief in Him and His Word. The flow of God stops when faith stops. If we keep on believing, the flow will never stop. This means that life is always manifesting, and death is being stopped. Just think about this: if our heart stops, our body will die. If the Holy

Ghost stops flowing in us, our spiritual lives will stop manifesting God.

So study this subject, and keep believing, and keep the flow happening; then you will be able to supply to people what God wants to give them.
