There's Power in the Word of God

The Word of God has more power in it than any substance that is in this natural world. All of the explosive substances, like dynamite, nuclear bombs, etc. cannot match the power of what's in God's Word! When God created this whole world, He spoke His Word; and things that were not became things that are.

I have been thinking about what God actually gave us when He gave us His Word, and I'm so happy I can hardly contain myself! I've been meditating on when we receive His Word by faith, it allows us to start doing things on His level. Let me give you an example: imagine a poor person that didn't have enough money to buy a car or live in a decent home, but then someone gave them 10 billion dollars; what a drastic change would come to their life! Well money has power to change a lot of things, but God's Word has more power in it than all the money in the world. I'm going to give you a lot of Scriptures that tell us the power that is in God's Word when we speak it in faith. Now I want you to take these Scriptures, and blow up the devil's work in your life and the lives of others' as well.

Proverbs 4:20-22 KJV My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. [21] Let them not depart from thine

eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. [22] For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

Psalm 103:20 KJV Bless the LORD, ye His angels, that excel in strength, that do His commandments, hearkening unto the voice of His Word.

Psalm 119:105 KJV Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

Acts 3:1-9 KJV Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour. [2] And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple; [3] Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms. [4] And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us. [5] And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them. [6] Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. [7] And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. [8] And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God. [9] And all the people saw him walking and praising God:

Mark 11:22-23 KJV And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. [23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Luke 10:17-21 KJV And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name. [18] And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from Heaven. [19] Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. [20] Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in Heaven. [21] In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank Thee, O Father, Lord of Heaven and Earth, that Thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in Thy sight.

In all these Scriptures we see the Power of God flowing through people to help people.

When God created the earth, He said some things; and those things came to pass. God made us in His image to speak not only His desires, but our desires as well.

Don't live just a natural life; live in the power of the Holy Ghost!
