August Pastor's Corner

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

-Matthew 19:14

In Jesus' day, children were not typically seen as "whole people" or members of society until they were old enough to contribute to the wellbeing of a household. Life expectancy was dramatically different from our lifetimes as well. Jesus' disciples assumed they were doing necessary work, keeping the droves of children who were being brought to Jesus away from him. He was important, after all, a holy man who should not be bothered!

Except... that Jesus rebuked the disciples when he saw parents bringing their children to him. "Let the little children come to me," he declared. And, as though he is making sure that the disciples understand that he's made no error here, he emphasizes that the kingdom of heaven *belongs* to them.

You need only tune in to our live-streamed service to see what chaos my own crew of small children can bring! They can be messy and demanding and noisy and have no idea what makes something holy or not... but you know what else children bring? A earnest belief that what we tell them is true, a hunger to participate in what we do in worship and in ministry, and an enthusiasm and energy we can only pine for!

As we prepare for the children in our midst to return to school, I invite you to pay attention to our young people in worship. What barriers do you notice that might prevent them from fully participating in the life of our congregation? How might we work on opening ourselves up to help our little children come to Jesus? I cannot over-state my gratitude for your patience in welcoming our noisy crew to Trinity. I am thrilled to watch as more and more children are engaged in the life of our church! Let us lean into our mission for all generations and "be a growing community of disciples of Jesus Christ, called by the Holy Spirit to share the Good News of God's love with all!"

Updates from the July 18, 2023 Council Meeting

Treasurer's Report:

Giving continues to be above the current budgeted amount for June. Trinity's expenses are beginning to level out.

Trinity has been designated as a beneficiary of the estates of two long time members. This is indeed a blessing to Trinity!

Ministry Report:

Pastors' Reports

Pastor Jason reported on the 2023 Synod Assembly. During the month of June, there was one baptism and one death.

New members' classes will be held August 20th, 27th, and September 6th; Pastors will be seeking mentors/sponsors for our new members.

Acolyte training will be held during confirmation class time. Fifth and sixth graders will be asked to attend the training if interested.

Liturgical Deacon and Lector training will occur in August and September.

Council members approved:

Motion from the Car Hop Committee to provide \$1000 from the Youth Ministry Fund to the Outreach Ministry Committee to help fund "Soles for Souls", a program to purchase shoes for the children in the Grandparents Raising Grandchildren from the Shoe Dept. at Westmoreland Mall.

The resignation of Lynette Patterson from Council because of work related conflicts. Council will appoint an individual to serve the remaining five months of her term.

A review of the 2024 budget will be held on November 5, 2023 between services. All are welcome to attend.

The Annual Business Meeting to be held November 18 & 19, 2023 after each service to vote on the 2024 Budget, elect new Council members, and vote on the proposed constitutional changes from the 2022 churchwide Assembly.

The Car Hop Committee submitted their report from the 2023 Car Hop. A total of \$7009.28 was raised, the largest amount to date! \$709.28 will be donated to the Trinity Christmas Basket Fund and \$6300.00 will be added to the Youth Ministry Fund in preparation for the 2024 National Youth Gathering in New Orleans. The gathering is July 16-20, 2024.
