VII. Communications:

Church council, Special Gifts and Finance Committee received a lovely thank you letter from Kathe Houck for funding her upcoming Lay Worship Leader program enrollment.

VIII. Treasurer's Report

- A. The checking account balance at the end of June was \$34,823.92.
- B. Giving during church services is still good.
- C. Wages, salaries, and office costs are still balancing.
- D. Building expenditures are up due to some A/C repairs the church needed.
- E. Cash flow is better than planned, and the deficit is lower than originally predicted.
- F. The Car Hop turned a good profit.
- G. The Finance Committee makes a motion that we renew our Mission Investment Fund CD of \$20,000 for a 3-year term at a fixed rate of 4.4%.
- H. Darlene Hoffmann made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report; motion seconded by Cheryl Morgan.

IX. Ministry Report

- A. VBS is currently underway and going well. (July 14-16) Post cards were sent out inviting the kids, and a few participants said that was what brought them into VBS.
- B. More summer events are planned such as Pine Springs Day Camp done in tandem with other local churches.
- C. Even though it is vacation season, church attendance has remained strong.

- D. Men's Communion Breakfast had 113 attendees, including some from other churches.
- E. We elected a new Bishop at the Synod Convention in June: Melissa Stoller, who offers both experience and a new perspective. Her induction ceremony will take place on October 18, 2025.
- F. Bishop Kusserow's farewell party will be held on August 10, 2025, at Lutherlyn.
- G. Hospital visits were slightly down in June due to some pastoral vacation time, but they are increasing quickly again.

X. Unfinished Business

- A. Boiler Financing has been obtained with a lien on the church for \$65,000, but the interest has decreased from 8% to 7.06%.
- B. First Commonwealth Bank checking will take our check, and then pay James S. Gunst from that.
- C. Committee Chair Nominations update: Rachael Marinchek will chair Children/ Youth Ministry Committee; Lucinda Nicely will chair the Personnel Committee.

XI. New Business

- A. Green Sheets must be approved by someone other than the person requesting the money due to auditing requirements. Council representatives pass this information to committees.
- B. Motion from the Executive Committee to accept a contract with the Westmoreland Intermediate Unit. The motion passed unanimously.
- C. New and transferring member's update: Transfers from St. James Lutheran Church in Youngstown include Erica Ferry, Gracelyn Ferry, and Caleb Ferry; also Joan Akins from Prince of Peace church in Latrobe.
- D. **Motion to accept these transfer/new members** Donna Showalter; seconded by Cheryl Morgan. Passed unanimously.
- E. Safety and Security Update: A discussion of plans for exterior door keys and which doors will be locked during which hours ensued. Some highlights were:
 - Reminder to security that Sunday School doors must be unlocked by 10:30 to guardians to pick up minor children. *Have a watch volunteer open it if needed.

 - 3. We had a lengthy discussion about the cameras and how to best use them.
