Pastor's Corner

May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had, so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. – Romans 15:5-6 (NIV)

As a church, we often talk about the various liturgical seasons that mark the rhythm of our year, beginning with Advent and winding through Epiphany, Christmas, Lent, Easter, eventually Pentecost, and the long season after. But have you heard of my favorite non-liturgical season? Soup season.

One pot fills us up for supper and often makes its way into lunches to get us most of the way through the rest of the week. Soup is more than easy nutrition, though. It holds rich history and often tells a story if we're willing to listen to it! You may not think, at first, that this is true of Chicken Noodle Soup, but it is!

But did you know that this "American Classic" is believed to trace its roots to Asia along the Silk Road? It likely began in China nearly 2,000 years ago alongside other noodle style soups, utilizing ingredients like ginger and scallions. It made its way to Vietnam where it morphed into what is now served as Pho (pronounced "fuh"). And eventually to Europe and into North America where even more variations were born. From Chicken Corn Soup (with rivels!) to Slippery Pot Pie, we Pennsylvanians have several versions of our own!

We are richer as a people in this world to have each version of these soups and their soup descendants in our collective lives. We can learn so much about one another by sharing our tables and our stories.

As we enter this Soup Season, I invite you to cook up your favorite version of Chicken Noodle Soup or perhaps you might order a variation from a Thai or Vietnamese restaurant. Invite a neighbor or friend into your home to share it with you. Ponder the heritage you have inherited along with the lineage of others and most especially the gifts we share in common. In a time when it feels like our world is fractured, dividing over every bit of news, let's break bread with one another and watch for the ways in which God calls us to love our neighbors near and far.

Shepherd Shop




The Shepherd Shop is in need of new children's/youth's socks and underwear. If you would

Note: Income for August includes \$12,000.00 of endowment money. Income is almost the same as planned in the budget. Expenses continue to be less than planned due to everyone helping to keep cost down. The current deficit is \$23,579.63. This is about 40% of what was expected. Last year at the same time, we had a deficit of \$34,556.99.
