July Church Council Update

- The Finance Committee recommended that we renew our Mission Investment Fund CD of \$20,000 for a 3-year term at a fixed rate of 4.4%, and that motion passed.
- We elected a new Bishop at the Synod Assembly in June: The Rev. Melissa Stoller, who offers both experience and a new perspective. Her installation will take place on October 18, 2025.
- A motion from the Executive Committee to accept a contract with the Westmoreland Intermediate Unit passed.
- Four more people have been accepted as new members at Trinity, so we continue our growth.
- On the social side, the Men's Communion Breakfast and VBS both had great turnouts!

Note: The income for June was \$5,481.77 better than planned. This includes \$12,000.00 of endowment funds used to support the budget. Thanks to everyone's generous giving and keeping expenses under control, the year to date deficit is \$20,235.78. This is about 40% of the expected one of \$51,175.00.

Note: Income for July includes \$12,000.00 of endowment funds. The income for July was \$3,506.06 less than planned, but year to date income is \$8,130.13 better than planned. Expenses were \$4,285.45 less than planned and year to date are \$23,588.48 less than planned. The current deficit is \$22,563.39 compared to \$29,890.04 this time last year.

2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly - Yehiel Curry elected Presiding Bishop of the ELCA

The Rev. Yehiel Curry was elected July 30 to serve a six-year term as presiding bishop of the ELCA. The election took place during the 2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly being held July 28—Aug. 2 at the Phoenix Convention Center.

Curry was elected on the fifth ballot. There were 799 votes cast, with 400 votes needed for an election. Curry received 562 votes, and Kevin Strickland, bishop of the ELCA Southeastern Synod, received 237 votes.

Curry has served as bishop of the ELCA Metropolitan Chicago Synod since 2019. He previously served as mission developer (2009-2012) and pastor (2012-2019) of Shekinah Chapel in Riverdale, Ill. He received a Bachelor of Arts from Lewis University in Romeoville, Ill., in 1995 and a Master of Divinity from the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago (LSTC) in 2013. Presiding Bishop-elect Curry will be installed on October 4 at Central Lutheran Church, Minneapolis.

In addition to the election of Curry, Pastor Lucille "CeCee" Mills was elected to a six-year term as secretary of the ELCA. Mills, an assistant to the bishop in the North Carolina Synod, was elected on the fifth ballot, receiving 404 votes to 378 votes for the Rev. Matthew Riegel, bishop of the West Virginia-Western Maryland Synod. A full report of elections, legislative actions, and other news will be posted at ELCA.org/CWA.
