## **Pray the Psalms - October**

All year long at Holy Cross we're praying the Psalms, once a day everyday a different Psalm each month. In September it was Psalm 100. In **October** it is **Psalm 46**.

The author of Psalm 46 expresses complete trust in God especially that He is present in His strength and His power. Five times the Psalmist asserts the presence of God. In verse 1 "God is...a very present help."

In verse 4, the "city of God" is called the "habitation of the Most High." The Hebrew word here for 'habitation' is the same word used for 'Tabernacle' and 'dwelling', i.e. the movable tent in the Old Testament that God said He was present in.

In verse 5, "God is in the midst of her (the city of God)."

In verse 7, "The LORD of hosts is with us." The word translated here to mean "hosts" comes from a military usage meaning "armies". The LORD of the heavenly army is with us is what it says.

Again in verse 11 the Psalmist repeats, "The LORD of hosts is with us."

God who promises to be with you is not weak. He calms and provides strength to His people (v.5). He is mightier than anything in all the earth (v.6-7). He is more powerful than any war or army that makes war (v.8-9). He is exalted above anything on earth (v.10).

Psalm 46 assumes the goodness of the LORD as proclaimed throughout the rest of Holy Scripture. When our fears rage, when our anxiety rises, when worry creeps in to our thoughts, Psalm 46 offers a defense. It offers strength.

"Be still and know that I am God."
