OBSERVE

- 1. What does Jesus promise his disciples?
- 2. What is the significance of Jesus calling the peace he gives "my peace"?
- 3.If we have Jesus' peace, how should that affect our hearts?

INTERPRET

- 1. What are the preconditions for "worldly peace"?
- 2. How does the world give? How does Jesus give?
- 3. What is it about the birth, death and resurrection of Jesus that results in believers having peace?

ASSESS

- 1. Would you describe your disposition as peaceful? Why or why not?
- 2. When do you most tend to feel peace?
- 3. When do you find your peace most disrupted?
- 4. If peace is a gift from Jesus, what should be able to take peace from you?
- 5. If nothing should be able to take peace from you, what leads to a lack of peace in your life?
- 6. When others are not at peace, what does it look like to help them find peace in Christ? Do you encourage others with his peace or the world's peace?
