REVIEW

OBSERVE

2. What does it mean to call God "holy"? (8)
3. What reason does verse 11 give for saying that God is worthy "to receive glory and honor and power"?

INTERPRET

1. Rather than giving God glory and honor and power, how do we approach glory, honor and power?
2. How does our pursuit of glory, honor and power affect our relationships? How does it affect our well-being?
3. How does worshiping God change our pursuit of glory, honor and power?

ASSESS

1. In what ways do you pursue glory, honor and power for yourself?
2. How are you actively worshiping God? How does your worship reflect God's holiness?
3. How is your life being shaped by knowing and trusting God's glory, honor and power? Where are you relying on your power rather than God's?
4. What parts of your life are worshiping God? What parts of your life are not worshiping God?
5. How is your life different when you are not worshiping God?
