PRAY FOR ONE ANOTHER

Thank you for praying for Ryan Collin's nephew, Tyler, who was badly injured in a trucking accident last week. He is currently stable and doing better. The swelling has gone down in his leg and he will be ready for surgery after another week of recovery. The surgery will involve inserting temporary pins or permanent screws to fix the breaks in his tibia, fibula, and ankle. He will be non-weight bearing until March. Please pray for his pain, that he would not become too reliant on pain medication, a successful surgery, and for his family.

Ingrid Prail will be having posterior thoracic surgery on September 15th to remove a large lung/ mediastinum cyst. Please pray that the surgery would go smoothly, be successful, and that there are no major long term negative outcomes. There are calcified areas on the cyst near and on top of two major heart veins, the trachea, as well as the lungs. Please pray that those areas would release the cyst better than expected. Pray for the hands of the doctors and for complete healing.

Please continue to pray for Steve Ewing. Although the doctors found no cancer, Steve is still having trouble with his lungs. He is awaiting the results of a bronchoscope biopsy to see if they missed anything. If the doctors do not find something new, they may have to open his chest to get a larger sample. His lungs look like there should be cancer, but they can not find any. Please pray for Steve and Debbie, as well as the doctors, as they try to find answers.

Christina Cochard, Gayle Harrsion's 29-year-old niece, has Fanconi Anemia and Acute Myeloid Leukemia. Chemotherapy will begin sometime in September, followed immediately with a bone marrow transplant. Please pray that her brother will be a match and donor for her transplant. Also pray that Christina's faith and hope will be strong as she fights this battle.

Please lift up Lou Anne Cottingham in prayer as she urgently seeks safe, stable, housing. Her current van/RV is no longer running or livable, and she will need assistance relocating once a place is secured. Pray for peace and clarity as she navigates critical decisions this week—including medical appointments and a significant business meeting. Ask for wisdom, strength, and the Lord's protection over her health and every step ahead.

Please pray weekly for Pastor Brett and all preachers/teachers for guarding them from the evil one, spiritual diligence, and boldness in proclaiming the truth.
