They will leave on January 18 and return on January 26. Pray for the gathering and packing of items to take to bless the Cuban families, the sermon and lesson planning, and for the church's invitations to lost family, friends and neighbors.

Please pray for R.J. Walls, Anthony Cope's nephew. He has had the first 2 out of 12 chemo sessions. He is feeling pretty good overall. The doctors will scan after the 12th session to see if the treatment is working. RJ was baptized on January 4th.

Please be in prayer for Brent Govert. He has just completed ten radiation treatments for his cancer. The treatments became very painful and he had a severe cough. The doctors have decided to hold off on chemo for a couple of more weeks. Please keep Brent and Cindy in your prayers.

Please pray for Mike and Charlotte Parr's grandson, Nicholas. He is being treated for neuroendocrine cancer. He has completed his first 8 weeks of IV chemotherapy. While his blood work is stable and his liver is functioning, the latest MRI is showing that the chemotherapy has not caused the tumors to shrink. He will begin another cycle of treatment, this time with oral chemotherapy. It is known to stay in the body longer than IV chemotherapy. He will take this form of treatment for another 8 weeks. Please pray that he can tolerate the oral therapy and for the tumors to shrink. Thank you for your prayers.

Please commit to praying weekly for our church leadership, particularly Pastor Brett and our preachers. Your prayers are vital in seeking the Spirit's guidance, protection, and boldness for our leaders as they proclaim God's truth. Let us also pray for open hearts among all listeners, especially those searching for the faith. Please stand with us in faith as we grow, serve, and engage our community.
