1. What is the Church? (What Jesus Has Already Done)

- Jesus' promise: Matthew 16:18 "I will build my church"
- Pentecost (Acts 2:1-12, 37-41)
- Living Stones: 1 Peter 2:4-12
- The church as:

A work of Jesus

Holy

One (unified in Christ)

Powerful

How the church begins to take form:

- A Holy Nation: Diversity in unity (Jews, Gentiles, various ethnic groups, social classes)
- **The Body of Christ:** Diverse members working together (1 Corinthians 12:12-27)
- **Spirit-Empowered:** Temple of the Spirit

The church is: The Authentic Presence of God in the world- Craig Van Gelder (The essence of the Church)

Key Point: The church remains what Christ made it, even when actions falter.

- Preaching & Teaching (Doctrine)
- Prayer & Worship
- Sacraments: Communion & Baptism
- Fellowship & Discipleship
- Serving Others:

Widows, orphans, hungry, lost, hurting, enemies
