### A CHALLENGE: LIVE RIGHTEOUSLY

1. \_\_\_\_\_: blameless character. (v. 2, 4)
2. \_\_\_\_\_: righteous conduct. (v. 2, 5)

### A REALIZATION: NO ONE CAN REALLY LIVE THIS WAY

### A SOLUTION: JESUS CHRIST LIVED THIS WAY

## Psalms 15:1-5

- <sup>1</sup> Lord, who may dwell in your sacred tent?  
Who may live on your holy mountain?
  - <sup>2</sup> The one whose walk is blameless,  
who does what is righteous,  
who speaks the truth from their heart;
  - <sup>3</sup> whose tongue utters no slander,  
who does no wrong to a neighbor,  
and casts no slur on others;
  - <sup>4</sup> who despises a vile person  
but honors those who fear the Lord;  
who keeps an oath even when it hurts,  
and does not change their mind;
  - <sup>5</sup> who lends money to the poor without interest;  
who does not accept a bribe against the innocent.
- Whoever does these things  
will never be shaken.
