Council Update

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Messiah Lutheran Church is a busy, active place, and the Council wants to ensure everyone is informed about what's happening behind the scenes. I hope to communicate some of our updates on a monthly basis. Here is what we have been working on during the summer:

- Faith Formation Leader: Our Call Committee met with the Synod in July, and discussed the length of the call process (18-24 months on average). This is longer than any of us really wanted, so the Call Committee proposed a "hybrid" option, where we could hire a part-time rostered leader to support congregational needs and a non-rostered Faith Formation leader. Council is investigating this option as a parallel path to the current call process.
- **Outreach:** Dana Burton has agreed to step back into the role of Outreach Council Representative. Thank you, Dana! This means our Fellowship Council Representative role is now vacant. If you feel called to help foster the "spiritual communion within the congregation," please reach out. Fellowship is essential in our life as a community faith! Even if you aren't stepping into an official role, we can help you organize a fellowship opportunity.
- **Parking lot:** Just before this project was scheduled to start, we learned that the paving contractor was behind schedule. Stay tuned for a planned rescheduled date. We appreciate your flexibility and understanding as we work with the contractor.
- Reorganizing the education wing: We have been moving, updating, and reorganizing some of the classrooms and offices to better make use of our available space. As part of that, we now have an office for our Music Director! Signage has been updated to reflect the changes. A huge thank you to everyone who helped with this effort, especially Joe and Bobbey Huwalt!
- Parish Hall kitchen refrigerator: Sadly our Parish Hall kitchen refrigerator needs to be replaced. Faced with a third repair in a year, Council approved purchasing a replacement using funds from the Capital Improvement Fund. Your contributions to this fund make quickly addressing emergent needs such as this possible! Thank you!
- **Endowment Fund:** The Endowment Committee is working to establish an endowment fund for MLC. Once the details are finalized, more information will be communicated.
- **Membership Update:** We are reviewing and updating our membership records. We haven't updated our roster in several years, so we are reaching out to those who haven't been active within the past year to understand if life circumstances have changed or if they need spiritual support. We want to remain connected, but also need to maintain accurate records. This also provides an opportunity for us to learn and discern what we as a congregation can do to improve those connections.
- Long Range Planning: We will be establishing a Long Range Planning Committee to plan for the future of Messiah Lutheran Church. The last long range plan was done in 2016, so it's time. Your input and involvement will be needed as part of this process! Stay tuned for more info.

As always, I look forward to all the Spirit has in store for us as we continue to be "God's People, Reaching Out." Yours in Christ,
