I wonder, now that Christmas is over and we've begun to settle into a new year, has any of us paused long enough to consider the answer to the question of the wise men:


"Where is the child, born king of the Jews?"



Mission Endowment Fund

The Mission Endowment Fund Committee has been working hard to define and establish guidelines for Messiah's Mission Endowment Fund. We have completed the Continuing Resolution, which will guide the fund's management, growth, and the funding of future grant proposals that lift up the ministry and outreach of our congregation.

The congregation voted to allocate a portion of the parsonage sale proceeds to help establish the fund. After researching several financial management institutions, the committee recommended Thrivent to the Church Council for approval, and the council accepted the recommendation.

We are now working to complete the application process to officially establish the MLC Mission Endowment Fund – Madison, AL, with Thrivent Financial. Once the fund is officially established, it will take time to grow to a point where we can begin to solicit and distribute grants. The timeframe for this to begin will be when the initial investment (principal) doubles.

Future grants will be offered and distributed from interest and/or dividends only.

The Endowment Fund will continue to grow and be a blessing for sharing the love of Christ with our congregation and beyond.

One of the many ways to share your generosity is through legacy giving. Simply put, legacy giving is remembering Messiah's ministry and the Mission Endowment Fund in your estate planning. The Endowment Committee will be giving a temple talk during worship in January about legacy giving.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
Happy New Year! I wanted to provide two updates from the council:

1. We are still in the call process for a rostered minister of faith formation, and that process continues as we await what God has planned for MLC. However, as that search continues, we are working to hire an interim, part-time youth leader. Our youth volunteers have been doing an amazing job organizing and leading activities and events, which is a considerable amount of hard work—thank you! With this interim position, we want to ensure there is additional support for our youth program and also provide our volunteers with a chance to recharge and refocus.

We will keep you updated as we work through this interim plan.

2. I had previously shared that we were going to begin our long-range planning in 2025. However, it has taken a bit longer than anticipated to finalize the charter for the committee. We want to make sure we are asking the Long-Range Planning Committee to focus on and provide discernment around the right questions. The new goal is to kick off that committee later in January.

I am excited to see what this new year holds for us as we continue to shine God's light in the world and discern how best to be God's people reaching out.



Synod Revival Days: 2026





Adult Bible Study


Adult Bible study resumes Jan. 11 with a study of *Luther's Small Catechism, An Explanation*.
