Don't STOP until you're DONE.

1 Samuel 14

²⁰ Then Saul and all his men rushed out to the battle and found the Philistines killing each other. There was terrible confusion everywhere. ²¹ Even the Hebrews who had previously gone over to the Philistine army revolted and joined in with Saul, Jonathan, and the rest of the Israelites. ²² Likewise, the men of Israel who were hiding in the hill country of Ephraim joined the chase when they saw the Philistines running away.

²³ So the LORD saved Israel that day, and the battle continued to rage even beyond Beth-aven.

They chased and killed the Philistines all day from Micmash to Aijalon, growing more and more faint . . . ³⁶ Then Saul said, "Let's chase the Philistines all night and plunder them until sunrise. Let's destroy every last one of them."

- One of the reasons we don't experience true
 <u>VICTORY</u> is because we settle for <u>MEDIOCRITY</u>.
- You'll never experience <u>VICTORY</u>
 if you make <u>PROVISION</u> for <u>FAILURE</u>.

Q: What battle do you still need to fight?

Don't **BOAST** in the **VICTORY**.

1 Samuel 15
