^{2:19} Now the LORD God had formed from the ground all the wild animals and all the birds of the sky. He brought them to the man to see what he would call them, and **Adam chose a name for each one**. ²⁰ He gave names to all the livestock, all the birds of the sky, and all the wild animals.

name it: shem - "to mark with a sign, to put in place"
