WHERE is God Sending You?

1. God is sending you to the EVERYDAY places.

Acts 1

⁸ Jesus said, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere."

John 17

¹⁸ Jesus prayed, "Just as you sent me into the world, I am sending them into the world."

*EVERY place is a God place
when God PLACES you there.*

Matthew 5

¹⁴⁻¹⁶ Jesus said, “You are the light of the world - like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.”

Q: How can you be a light in the dark places today?

2. God is sending you to a SPECIFIC place.

Genesis 2

¹⁵ The LORD God placed the man (Adam) in the Garden of Eden to work it and to watch over it.

Acts 17

²⁶ From one man, God made every nation to live over the whole earth and has determined their appointed times and the boundaries of where they live.

*You may not be where YOU THOUGHT you'd be,
but you're exactly where GOD KNEW you would be.*

Q: Where has God placed YOU?

Q: Why do you think God placed you THERE?

Q: How would today be different if you knew
that God placed you there on PURPOSE?

3. God is sending you to the HARD places.

Luke 14

^{21b} The Master said, “Go quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and invite the poor, the crippled, the blind, and the lame.” ²² After the servant had done this, he reported, “There is still room for more.” ²³ So his master said, “Go out into the country lanes and behind the hedges and urge anyone you find to come, so that the house will be full.”

We usually spend our whole life trying to AVOID the PEOPLE and PLACES that God is sending us to.

4. God is sending you to the UNREACHED places.

Luke 10

¹ The Lord chose seventy-two other disciples and sent them ahead in pairs to all the towns and places he planned to visit. ² These were his instructions to them: “The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields. ³ Now GO, and remember that I am SENDING you out...”

Matthew 28

¹⁹⁻²⁰ Jesus said, “GO and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teaching them to obey all the commands I have given you.”

The Great Commission isn't a SUGGESTION - it's a COMMAND.
