

Prayer BINGO Guide

PRAY!

We need to cover our community in prayer. Prayer is the primary work of God's people. Nothing of lasting Kingdom value occurs without the work of prayer. Kingdom work in Pearl City begins when we intercede on behalf of the community.

GO!

Go to the desired location labeled on the P.R.A.Y.S. challenge board and pray for that location. Walk around, observe who is coming and going, and listen to what God might be saying. Remember prayer walking is about listening and speaking.

BINGO!

After praying, you can mark the square completed on your P.R.A.Y.S. challenge board.

Get a Bingo by completing a prayer challenge from each of the P.R.A.Y.S sections in a single row, or go for a 'black out' of all 25 challenges!

Exercising Authority

"Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. "Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."

Matthew 18:18-20

God wants every local church to learn to exercise their authority in Christ to bind and loose. This is one of the greatest responsibilities given by Christ to His church. We want to learn to utilize our authority, to exercise extraordinary influence over the community God has placed us in.

What do we bind? We bind what is evil. What do we loose? We loose what is good.

"Bind" – To bind is to prohibit – to restrain. You bind what is evil – curses, sins, demonic influences, bad attitudes, the words of evil, negative outcome.

"Loose" - To loose is to permit - to release. You loose what is good - blessings, the knowledge of God, the authority of God, positive

outcomes.

Binding and loosing is simple. Don't make it more complex than it needs to be. Even though it's simple, don't neglect its far reaching impact.



Who are we Praying for?

- **P** (Parks and Recreation): There are nearly 15 park and recreation centers in this city. In each of these places, many community events take place, including sports leagues and social gatherings. Let's pray for these parks!
- R (Restaurants and Businesses): There are a multitude of restaurants and retail businesses in Pearl City. These places provide many jobs as well as meet the needs of many people, they need prayer. Let's pray for these places!
- A (Areas of Pearl City): There are seven major areas of Pearl City. While all of these residential areas of Pearl City have different demographics, the residents share one thing in common: they need the LORD.
- Y (Youth): There are 11 schools in the Pearl City District.

 Through prayer, the young generation may know that Jesus loves and supports them unconditionally.
- S (Seniors): Roughly 20% of Pearl City's Population (about 10,000 individuals) are senior citizens. In our fast-paced world, senior citizens bring wisdom and resilience to our community. By praying for them, we show appreciation, combat loneliness, and connect generations.

Pray for the Parks

- · Safe place for family visits and recreation
- Free from gangs, drugs, and illegal activities
- Proper monitoring by security personnel
- Christians to be personal witnesses to those in the parks
- Pray for the Holy Spirit's presence in the territory
- For those without a home in this park
- Protection from vandalism and misuse
- Preservation of the buildings and environment



Pray for the Retail/Restaurants

- Support a Local Business!
- Christian workers to demonstrate Christ's love as they serve customers
- Workers to have physical strength to meet the daily demands of their work
- Owners to be fair and just with their workers, and conduct affairs with integrity and legitimacy
- Financial success to contribute to the city's economy and boost employment
- · Pray for the workers' well being and spiritual hunger
- Pray for the consumers' well being and spiritual hunger
- Resilience through business struggles

- For more Christ centered partnerships in the school


Pray for the Seniors
