SUNDAY, NOV. 16 – Overflowing Grace

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 9:8–11

Revived hearts become generous hearts. Gratitude never stays still—it spills over.

Prayer: God, make my life an overflow of Your grace to others.

MONDAY, NOV. 17 – Sent in Gratitude

Scripture: Isaiah 6:8

The revived heart doesn't just say "thank You"—it says "send me." True thanksgiving always turns into mission.

Prayer: Lord, send me where gratitude becomes service.

TUESDAY, NOV 18 - A Witness of Joy

Scripture: Philippians 2:14–16

A thankful Christian is a bright testimony in a complaining world. Joyful contentment is revival's megaphone.

Prayer: Spirit, help me shine with joy that points others to Christ.

WEDNESDAY, NOV. 19 – A Kingdom of Givers

Scripture: Matthew 10:8

You have received freely; now give freely. Revival looks like open hands, not clenched fists.

Prayer: Father, make me generous in time, grace, and love.

THURSDAY, NOV. 20 – The Harvest of Thanksgiving

Scripture: Psalm 67:3–5

When the world sees grateful people living with joy and peace, they see God's goodness. Gratitude is global witness.

Prayer: Lord, may my gratitude draw others to Your grace.

FRIDAY, NOV. 21 – Daily Renewal

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 4:16

You don't need to wait for a spiritual high to experience revival. Every day, grace renews what life wears down.

Prayer: Father, revive me daily with fresh grace and perspective.

SATURDAY, NOV. 22 – Grace at the Table

Scripture: Psalm 23:5

Every meal, every breath, every moment of laughter is grace. Revival begins when we stop taking grace for granted.

Prayer: Thank You, Lord, for filling my cup beyond measure.
