THURSDAY, NOV. 20 – The Harvest of Thanksgiving

Scripture: Psalm 67:3-5

When the world sees grateful people living with joy and peace, they

see God's goodness. Gratitude is global witness.

Prayer: Lord, may my gratitude draw others to Your grace.

FRIDAY, NOV. 21 - Daily Renewal

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 4:16

You don't need to wait for a spiritual high to experience revival. Every

day, grace renews what life wears down.

Prayer: Father, revive me daily with fresh grace and perspective.

SATURDAY, NOV. 22 – Grace at the Table

Scripture: Psalm 23:5

Every meal, every breath, every moment of laughter is grace. Revival

begins when we stop taking grace for granted.

Prayer: Thank You, Lord, for filling my cup beyond measure.
