Communio n Liturgy

Leader I: The Lord be with you.

People: And also with you.

Leader 2: Generous God whose story and song are now and always the hope of the world, we praise You for the stories of creation and incarnation, redemption and resurrection. We rejoice in Your song of yearning and calling, waiting and welcoming, gathering and cherishing the eternal music of hope. And we join our voices now in that great song of love and adoration that creation sings to You.

People: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might. Heaven and earth are full of Your glory!

- Leader I: This bread is a sign of hope, it tells the story of dying and rising, of breaking and sharing, of nourishment and strengthening, of Jesus' body being more than enough. On the night before His death, Jesus took bread and broke it with friends, saying, "Take, eat. This is my body broken for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
- Leader 2: This wine is a sign of hope it holds a story of dying and rising, of pouring and sharing, of refreshment and renewal, of Jesus' blood being more than enough. On the night before His death, Jesus took wine, and sharing it with His friends, said, "This is my blood of the new covenant which is poured out for many. Do this in remembrance of me."
- Leader I: As we share these holy gifts, we remember the Lord Jesus. For the love He shared with us, and the hope He now gives us, and so we acclaim You, O Christ: Dying You destroyed our death. Rising, You restored our life. Christ Jesus, come in glory.
- Leader 2: And now, faithful God, send down Your Holy Spirit on us and our celebration, that the story of hope, of Your death and rising to new life and the fruit of the kingdom, may continue in us, and through us. Send us as Your messengers into the world and fill us with energy, courage, hope, and love.

People: Now to You, most holy God, through Christ Your Son and in the Spirit's power, we bring our worship and our songs of praise. Amen.
