**Apply**

- Paul writes that we are "called to belong to Jesus Christ." What does that mean to you, personally?
- God's will is that we become disciple makers, telling the gospel story and calling others to join us in following Jesus. What might that look like in your life?

**Prayer**

- *Thank* God for the good news which is ours in Jesus Christ.
- *Ask* God to give you the words, the love, and the courage to share the gospel with others.
