

From the Pastor's view...INVINCIBLE, Though Invisible!

Recently, in the Jewish calendar, Purim was celebrated, remembering the deliverance of the Jews as told in the book of Esther. Christian author Chuck Swindoll once wrote about Esther from the Old Testament and her life situation that, "though God is invisible, He is invincible."

A few years ago, I remember doing a message on the journey that God took Esther on as a young queen. And though her experience was certainly not easy, it was quite easy to see God's hand, His faithfulness and constant presence in her life.

In essence, Esther was handed a pretty big problem. She was challenged to help save the lives of her own people, the Israelites. So as queen, she could have exerted her power in the kingdom swiftly and quickly, to her advantage. However, she didn't do it quite like they would have expected.

The story is told that in chapter four, verses 15-17, Esther asks her relative, Mordecai, to fast for three days and wait, because there is a plan. And that plan involved, first waiting and trusting in the Lord, for His plan. Essentially, Mordecai and Esther were hoping that God was going to deliver the people from the hands of an evil adversary. And eventually it happened!

For Esther and the Israelites, it was an amazing example of God's love, faithfulness and power from beginning to end.

Now you are probably reading this newsletter either on, or a few days after, the greatest example of God's plan taking place. The resurrection of Jesus! Another powerful way that God's faithfulness to not only Jesus, but to all humanity is shown.

IN the resurrection, we see God's power in defeating death!

We remember God's love for the people then and now!

We celebrate Jesus's victory!

Because although the Romans and religious leaders hoped to make Jesus invisible that fateful Good Friday, the resurrection truly proved that He was INVINCIBLE!

Let me encourage you this month, that no matter what situations you may be experiencing, there is great comfort and peace for us as we remember the stories of Esther and Jesus. Trust in His plan! He is faithful, and we need to remember that there is great power and strength as we relax and wait on Him, in His timing.

God is invincible, though invisible!

Angie and I count it a blessing to be in ministry with you during this time, as we continually seek to be the 'hands and feet' of Jesus to the Mid-tidewater area.




