With the help of a fox, two new friends and an older woman from the woods, Elita learns so much about herself, about God, and being seated with Christ and how to show God's love to others who are hurting. This book is geared for 8-12-year-olds and for every grown woman who still has a "middle school girl" deep inside. Discussion/thoughtful questions are included and would be a great book for Mom and daughter to read together.

Hang on to your seat and keep the lights on as you dive into Patricia Bradley's <u>Counter Attack</u>, Book 1 in the new Pearl River Series. This suspenseful novel draws you into the world of undercover detective Alex Stone investigating a string of murders with an unusual calling card found at each scene --- a white pawn and a note with a chess move printed on it. Working with Pearl Springs Chief of Police Nathan Landry, they enter the world of the dark web, cryptocurrency, video games, and high stakes danger. It won't take you long to devour this gripping story.

<u>Seven More Men: And the Secret of Their Greatness</u> by Eric Metaxas (non-fiction) Heroes and role models have always been essential for inspiring our lives and shaping the world. But in the last few decades, the need for men of valor and integrity is more vital than ever. Metaxas draws insights for our daily lives in this book from the history of Martin Luther, George Whitefield, General William Booth, George Washington Carver, Sergeant Alvin York, Alexander Solzhenitsyn and Billy Graham.

<u>The Heart's Choice</u> is the first novel in the new series The Jewels of Kalispell by Tracie Peterson and Kimberley Woodhouse. This story is set in the early 1900's in Montana. After witnessing a wrongful conviction as a young girl, Rebecca Whitman is now determined to defend the innocent. During a murder trial as her position as the court reporter, something doesn't sit well with her about the case, but no one will listen to her except the new Carnegie librarian. Rebecca seeks the help of the librarian with research in hopes of proving a man's innocence. Will they be able to uncover the truth before it is buried forever?
