







There are surprising twists and turns as Delaney and Hunter join forces to solve the murders of Delaney's brother Corey and her best friend Ellie. Oddly, the methods are similar, but they take place ten years apart. This novel is about second chances and trusting God in the midst of horrible tragedy. (Read and reviewed by Norene Sattler)

I've heard it said that "Laughter is good medicine; it's like jogging on the inside." If that's the case, then I logged some miles while reading <u>Meet Me in the Margins</u> by Melissa Ferguson. Aspiring novelist Savannah keeps her secret ambition from her co-workers, until they see her drop her manuscript. Quickly stashing her manuscript away in a hidden nook, she is shocked when she retrieves it only to find that it has been critically marked up. Who is this mystery editor that is tampering with her work? Are the remarks worth taking to heart? As the story progresses, the chaos and intrigue continue resulting in a delightful, lighthearted fun read.

<u>Count the Nights by Stars</u> by Michelle Shocklee takes us to the Tennessee Centennial Exposition in 1897. In this split-time historical novel, Audrey is tasked with clearing out a reclusive woman's room after she suffers a stroke. Love notes and memorabilia for the Tennessee Centennial Exposition hint at the disappearance of young women. This is a very well written story and I thoroughly enjoyed it, reading it in record time as I could hardly put it down. Drawing you in from the very first page, you will be intrigued and learn some historical facts as well including the origin of the slogan "good to the last drop."
