The highly anticipated second book in the Cape Cod Creamery Series has arrived! <u>The Secret to Happiness</u> by Suzanne Woods Fisher follows the first book, <u>The Sweet Life</u>. This story will draw you in and you'll be surprised at the events that take place. There are several things going on in the lives of our creamery friends and each one has lessons to learn and share with us in their journey. You'll be introduced to several new characters including the delightful little "cowboy" Leo who is quite wise at 6 years of age. Of course, there is plenty of ice cream to go around, so grab yourself a bowl and enjoy as you devour this story!

Robert Whitlow offers an intriguing legal thriller with his new book titled **Double Indemnity**. While Pastor Connor is counseling Matt and Elena Thompson, who are struggling with their marriage, Matt dies while on a business hunting trip. As Elena continues to seek support from Connor, she also seeks legal assistance from lawyer Liz Acosta. As police look into Matt's death -- was it an accident, suicide or murder -- While dealing with the pushy and demanding widow, Connor and Liz find themselves drawn to each other while searching for the truth -- and possibly finding themselves in harm's way. Whitlow does an incredible job of creating a legal thriller while aptly including romance, spiritual growth and the immense power of prayer. He creates deeply real and relatable characters, including extremely likable characters like prayer warriors Lyle and Sarah and their son Josh, and some that raise your hackles. He also includes several great themes, like God knows the end from the beginning; God is with us even in the difficult times and God will meet with us personally. This book includes discussion questions and is a suitable book club read.

<u>Famous for a Living</u> by Melissa Ferguson took me to a place and challenged me like I certainly didn't expect to be challenged. Written by the same author who brought us the book titled <u>Meet Me in the Margins</u>, I expected a lighthearted funny feel-good story. It is some of that but it's also a sobering, challenging look at just how connected, dare I say addicted, we are to our little "computers" we all carry around in our pockets and purses. This book includes questions for self-reflection, helps and discussion questions and would also be a great book club read.
