Kentucky packhorse librarian Tansy Calhoun does not mind the rough trails and long hours as she serves her Appalachian Mountain community during the Great Depression. Yet she longs to find love like the heroines in her books. When a charming writer comes to town, she thinks she might have found it--or is the perfect man closer than she thinks?

Perdita Sweet has called these mountains home for so long she is nearly as rocky as the soil around her small cabin. Long ago she thought she could love, but when the object of her affection up and married someone else, she stopped giving too much of herself away to others.

As is so often the case, it is easier to see what is best for others than to see what's best for oneself, and Perdita knows who Tansy should choose. But why would anyone listen to the romantic advice of an old spinster? (Synopsis from book cover)

Robin Jones Gunn, a familiar author, has two recent releases in her Haven Makers Series. The first book, titled <u>Becoming Us</u> focuses on Emily, who has recently moved from North Carolina to California with her husband and daughter. Emily finds herself longing for friendship and unexpectedly finds herself drawn into a group of women who are in a similar season of life. This group of five challenge each other to authentically connect, not only with one another, but also with God. In doing so they discover healing, release from soul wounds, and the freedom to become the mothers, sisters, and friends they've always wanted to be.


