

What This Year Will Look Like

"Where Love Makes Space" will shape us through practices, not slogans.

This year we will:

- Deepen Biblical study into soul-nourishment, not just information

- Create tables literal and figurative where neighbors sit sideby-side
- Expand our hands-in-the-dirt service to Waterford and beyond
- Train disciples of every age to pray, serve, lead, and bless
- And ask regularly, bravely, humbly:

Who is missing? Who do we need to make space for? Where is the Spirit widening us next?

We are not called to be a museum that preserves what once was. We are called to be a living garden - stretching toward light, bearing fruit, offering shade.

A Word Of Encouragement:

Let me say this clearly: I am proud of you. Proud of your courage to remain open to the Spirit. Proud of your tenderness toward one another. Proud of the way you love — in casseroles, in cards, in hugs, in prayers. I see Christ Lutheran — growing, stretching, learning, and becoming more fully who God calls us to be. And I believe — God is still shaping us, still widening us, still preparing us for more. This is who we are — and who we are becoming: a church Where Love Makes Space.

A Blessing as We Begin

May we sink our roots deep into God's unconditional love May we rise — not by effort, but by Spirit. May love widen us — and loosen whatever has become too small. And may this be the year where: **Love makes space.** And we become a church where everyone - truly everyone - is welcome. So, with courage, tenderness, and holy imagination - **let us create God's Kingdom on earth - one welcome, one table, one act of love at a time.**
