

Dear Church,

On that same day, we also observe All Saints' Day, a time to honor all the saints who have gone before us in faith and to give thanks for those who walk beside us now. As we adjust our clocks and the days grow shorter, we are reminded that time moves on, life changes, and yet God's promises remain unchanging and sure. The One who holds our past also holds our future, and in Him we find the hope and assurance that nothing not even death — can separate us from His love.


