John 1:29-41

What are some examples of things you learn on "Day One"?

What God wants brought to light today is highlighted by the command of John the Baptist: " \_\_\_\_\_!"

## **1. The Savior who has come for you is a Lamb.**

What signal did God say he would give John to identify the promised Savior?

When did God give this signal?
