The Worth of Jesus

- The sermon defined worship as giving worth. What are some things people commonly treat as "worthy" in our culture?
- In your own life, what tends to compete with Jesus for the highest place of worth?

Extravagant Worship and Resistant Objections

- Mary gave Jesus her best—financially costly and emotionally valuable. What might "your very best" look like in your life today?
- Why do you think a life of worship often looks foolish or wasteful to the watching world?

The Fragrance Fills the House

- John says, "The house was filled with the fragrance." What does that image stir in you?
- How does wholehearted worship change the atmosphere of a home, a workplace, a church?
- What is one area of your life where Jesus is inviting you to trust him with something precious?
