Ephesians 5:1-2

1. Our to Imitate God

Flowing out of our adoption by God through Jesus Christ, we are to be imitators of God. To mimic (not mock) the Living God is the command given to all who belong to Him through faith in the Lord Jesus.

By this it is evident who are the children of God, and who are the children of the devil: whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is the one who does not love his brother. ~ 1 John 3:10

2. Our ______ in Following God

For the believer, the command is to live in a perpetual motion of love. To follow the Lord is to continually practice the sacrificial expression of His divine command.

And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it. ~ 2 John 1:6

3. Our ______ of the Son of God

The unwavering love of Christ is the example set for every believer. How did Christ love? He loved you by giving His life as the acceptable sacrifice before His Father.

Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that his hour had come to depart out of this world to the Father, having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end. ~ John 13:1
