Ephesians 5:18-21

1. A Life_

The Spirit-filled life is a life under the Spirit's control. In contrast to having a life controlled by the flesh and filled with the world, the believer is to have their life controlled by and filled with the Spirit.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." \sim Acts 1:8

Does your life join in the chorus of praise being lifted up from the heart to the Lord? The first aspect of a Spirit-filled life is a vocal expression of joy shared with those who belong to Christ.

Every circumstance of the redeemed is punctuated with the knowledge that it is from the Lord. With gratitude for who God is and what He has done, let us always and continually give thanks.

Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. ~ 1 Thessalonians 5:18

With a consideration of that which will most glorify Christ, we must humbly submit to one another. No believer is of greater standing before God than another, and so in Christ we determine to do all that we can in the best interest of the other.

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. ~ Philippians 2:3-4
