Preschool Ministry Teacher Guide

Week 1: God Is Our Protector

Bible Verse: Psalm 91:1 — “God is my safe place.”

Focus: God keeps us safe.

Objectives:

- Know that God watches over us.
- Feel safe with God.

Discussion Questions (simplified):

1. What makes you feel scared?
2. Who can help you feel safe?
3. How can God help you feel safe?

Activity:

- Make a “God’s Shelter” craft: children draw or paste pictures of things that make them feel safe under a big cloud labeled “God’s Protection.”

Closing Prayer:

“Thank You, God, for keeping us safe. Amen.”

Week 2: God Gives Us Wisdom

Bible Verse: Proverbs 2:11 — “God helps me make smart choices.”

Focus: God helps us choose what is safe.

Objectives:

- Learn that listening and thinking carefully is part of God's protection.

Discussion Questions:

1. Who can help you make good choices?
2. What is a smart choice you can make today?

Activity:

- “Safe or Not Safe?” game: show pictures or scenarios, and children say if it's safe or not.

Closing Prayer:

“God, help me make good choices. Amen.”

Week 3: Courage and Care

Bible Verse: Joshua 1:9 — “Be brave! God is with you.”

Focus: God gives us courage and teaches us to be careful.

Objectives:

- Feel brave with God.
- Understand being careful is good.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is something you were brave to do?
2. How does God help you when you are afraid?

Activity:

- Role-play brave actions: saying “no” to unsafe things or helping a friend.

Closing Prayer:

“Thank You, God, for giving me courage. Amen.”

Week 4: Stay Close to God

Bible Verse: Proverbs 18:10 — “God is my safe tower.”

Focus: Being close to God keeps our hearts safe.

Objectives:

- Know ways to be close to God.
- Feel safe in His love.

Discussion Questions:

1. How can we stay close to God?
2. What helps you feel safe in your heart?

Activity:

- “Spiritual Safety Box”: decorate a small box with Bible verses, crosses, or stickers that remind them of God.

Closing Prayer:

“God, help me stay close to You. Amen.”

Week 5: Caring for Others

Bible Verse: Galatians 6:2 — “Help each other.”

Focus: God wants us to help and protect friends.

Objectives:

- Learn that helping others is part of God's plan.

Discussion Questions:

1. How can you help your friends?
2. How can you show kindness today?

Activity:

- Make a “Friendship Shield”: children draw ways they can help friends stay safe.

Closing Prayer:

“God, help me care for my friends. Amen.”

Week 6: Guard Your Heart and Mind

Bible Verse: Philippians 4:8 — “Think about good things.”

Focus: Good thoughts help us feel safe and happy.

Objectives:

- Learn to think about nice and true things.

Discussion Questions:

1. What happy thoughts make you feel safe?
2. How can we think about God's love?

Activity:

- “Thought Tree”: write or draw happy thoughts and stick them on a paper tree.

Closing Prayer:

“God, help me think about good things. Amen.”

Week 7: Staying Safe Online

Bible Verse: Proverbs 4:23 — “Keep your heart safe.”

Focus: God helps us make good choices online.

Objectives:

- Understand simple online safety.

Discussion Questions:

1. What should we share online?
2. Who can help if something online feels scary?

Activity:

- “Safe Online or Not?” game with pictures: children decide what is safe to do online.

Closing Prayer:

“God, help me stay safe on the computer and phone. Amen.”

Week 8: Saying “No” to Peer Pressure

Bible Verse: 1 Corinthians 15:33 — “Choose good friends.”

Focus: God helps us make safe choices, even when friends do wrong.

Objectives:

- Practice saying “no” when needed.

Discussion Questions:

1. What can you say if friends ask you to do something unsafe?
2. How can God help you choose right?

Activity:

- Role-play saying “no” politely to unsafe choices.

Closing Prayer:

“God, help me make good choices and be a good friend. Amen.”
