Zanesville Civic Chorus Heads to NY

The Zanesville Civic Chorus performs Christmas carols on November 30, 2025 at Radio City Music Hall as a prelude to the Rockettes. The Chorus then performs Handel's Messiah on December 1, 2025 at Carnegie Hall.

This concert trip to New York City came in response to an invitation to perform after DCINY viewed the annual Zanesville Messiah performance on the internet. The chorus has worked diligently throughout 2025 writing grants, organizing fundraisers, and attending many rehearsals in preparation for the trip. The chorus first performed at Carnegie Hall in 2019.

Handel's Messiah at Central Trinity

The **Zanesville Civic Chorus** performs its 96th annual production of **Handel's Messiah Oratorio** at CT on **Sunday, December 14**, at **6:00 p.m.** in our church sanctuary. Handel's Messiah is one of the most famous musical works in the world, taking words from Scripture and bringing them to life through Handel's music.

The 70-voice community chorus, along with five vocal soloists and chamber orchestra, is under the direction of Ann Lillie Briggs and sponsored by the Zanesville Thursday Music Club. Katlynn Border is one of the soloists, and numerous singers are members of the CT Music Ministry.

The performance will be live-streamed on our church website and app. The concert is free and open to the public. A freewill offering will be taken and given to a local charity in the "spirit of Handel." This year the offering will go to the Southeast Ohio chapter of Habitat for Humanity. Starting in January, we're kicking off **Winter Game Night at CT**, and you're invited!


