

# Summary

The sermon focuses on navigating through difficult seasons of life and maintaining faith during spiritual struggles. Using Psalm 42, the pastor explores how even strong believers like David experienced moments of questioning God and feeling abandoned, while emphasizing that God remains faithful despite our circumstances. The message centers around three key words: 'real' (acknowledging our struggles), 'seek' (continuing to pursue God), and 'remember' (recalling God's faithfulness).

5. How can remembering past experiences with God help us in present difficulties?
6. What are some practical ways we can 'seek God' during challenging times?
7. How does knowing that God is faithful impact how we handle life's struggles?
8. What role does community play in supporting each other through spiritual struggles?

## Life Application

This week, create a 'remembrance journal' where you write down specific times God has been faithful in your past. When facing challenges, refer back to these moments as reminders of God's consistent presence and care in your life.
