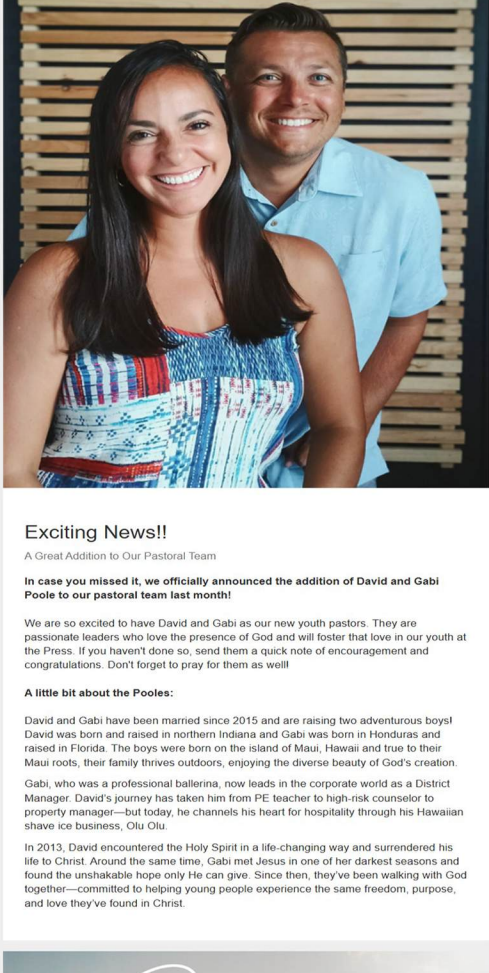

In case you missed it, we officially announced the addition of David and Gabi Poole to our pastoral team last month!

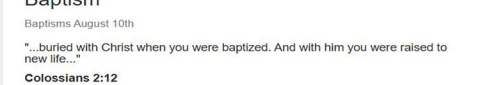

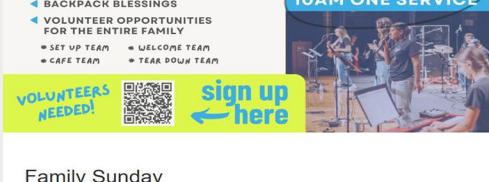
Pneuma Night

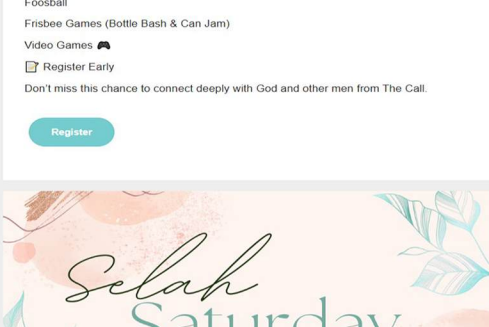
Your whole family is invited to this event! Free food, games and fun!

Pre-K/Kindergarten, Elementary & The Vine
