Summary of Position

The Director of Children's Ministries is responsible for planning, developing, and executing a comprehensive disciple-making ministry for all children (Birth through 5th Grade) at Mt. Zion Baptist Church. The Director is required to create a safe, nurturing, and Gospel-centered learning environment for kids to begin and/or grow in their relationship with Jesus, while providing a supportive, encouraging, and welcoming experience for parents and families.

Qualifications

- Possess a personal belief in and a growing relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior.
- A calling to the ministry and this type of work within the church.
- Possess a commitment to the inerrancy, infallibility, and inspiration of God's Word.
- Agree with Mt. Zion's stated mission and goals.
- A person of strong moral character who is not engaged in activities that would grieve the Holy Spirit or violate the membership covenant of Mt. Zion Baptist Church.
- Affirm the Baptist Faith and Message (2000), which is Mt. Zion's statement of faith.
- Member in good standing at current church.
- Experience leading in Children's Ministry or similar environments.
- Demonstrated experience serving in a growing and/or multi-service church environment, with an understanding of the challenges and opportunities that come with scaling children's ministry programming, volunteer teams, and family engagement.

Specific Responsibilities

- Direct the planning, organizing, conducting, coordinating, and ongoing evaluation of a comprehensive program of children's ministry, birth through 5th grade based on Mt. Zion's mission, vision, and strategy.
- Lead the planning and implementation of VBS and other events focused on children.
- Plan and implement yearly ministry events in conjunction with church calendar and church vision.
- Forecast and develop a 1 to 3 year children's ministry strategy that supports Gospel-formation in children, volunteer engagement and retention, and sustainable and healthy growth within the ministry.
- Recruit and train paid staff, leaders, teachers, and other volunteers to carry out the educational programs and activities associated with children's ministry (worship childcare, Sunday School, Thrive children's worship, Sprout preschool worship, Wednesday night activities, etc.).
- Prepare and administer the approved annual budget for Children's Ministries.
- Review and recommend, in collaboration with Lead Pastor, new material/resources, programs, curriculum, teaching methods, principles, procedures, promotion, and administration as related to areas of ministry.
- Conduct necessary steps to ensure safety and security of children during educational programs and activities (background checks, child check-in, etc.).
- Plan and organize events that support families in our church and community.
- Collaborate with Student Minister to create a smooth transition from 5th Grade to Student Ministry.
- Attend weekly church staff meetings.
- Praying with and for children, families, leaders and volunteers.
- Providing devotions for Children's Ministry volunteers.

Other Responsibilities

- Abide by Christian Code of Conduct specified in the church Employee Handbook concerning confidentiality, time and attendance, and professional demeanor commensurate with this position.
- Counsel parents as needed and document formal sessions.
- Seek opportunities to grow in their personal walk with the Lord.
- Attend, support, and promote church-wide events, including participation in ministries and activities outside of the assigned area of ministry.
- Keep the Pastor and additional staff informed of emergent situations.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Pastor and/or Operations Coordinator.
