Registration Procedure

We are thrilled to have you join us for the 2026-2027 school year! If you are a **New Family** or **Returning Family**, please see the corresponding instructions.

New Family:

To register your child for preschool:

1. Use the link at Step 7 to create a Procare account. You will get a confirmation number in an email to create your account.
2. Complete New Family Registration.
3. In 1-2 weeks, you will receive an email that verifies your child's placement.
4. Email your immunization form as a pdf or picture to katie@mtzb.org. Kindergarten students must also email in DPH Form 3300, which you can find on our [website](#).
5. You will receive a text to set up auto draft using either a credit card (2.75% fee) or bank draft (free), whichever you choose when you registered. After you set up your link, the registration fee will be drafted on the 5th of the following month beginning with March 5th.

6. Once your fee **and** immunization form (emailed to katie@preschool.org) are received, your spot will be held. Kindergarten students must additionally email in DPH Form 3300, which you can find on our [website](#).
7. If your child has allergies, complete and email the "Allergy Reaction Plan," found on the [website](#), to katie@mtzb.org.
8. Start your registration [HERE](#).

New Family Enrollment Process

Registration begins **February 23, 2026**

After clicking on the link below, you will receive a confirmation number. Continue to Register. **A Procare email will verify your application.**

MTZPreschool will review your registration. (This could take 1-2 weeks.)

Registration is date stamped so placement is a first come, first-serve basis. Office will email you with your status (available spot or waitlisted). Once you have a spot, you will receive a text to set up your autodraft.

Email your Immunization Form as a pdf or picture to katie@mtzb.org by the 5th of next month. Kindergarten students must email in an additional form: DPH Form 3300, which you can find on our [website](#).

The Registration Fee is due March 5th or the 5th of the month following Registration. Failure to email your child's Immunization Form **AND** to pay at that time will result in your child's spot being released.

If your child has allergies, complete and email the "Allergy Reaction Plan" to katie@mtzb.org. The form is found on the [website](#). A July email will contain information about calendar, Meet & Greet, class assignment, & supply lists. We look forward to meeting you!

Returning Family:

We are excited to have you return next year!

Adding a New child? Email khara@mtzb.org your New Child's name **AND** birthday. You will receive an email from the school that your child has been added to your current account. Then you can start "re-registration" and select a program for that child.

1. Use the link in Step 6. Your email and password are needed for access to your MyProcare account. If you have never used MyProcare, use the First time users link in Step 6. You will get a confirmation number in an email to create your account.
2. Begin ReRegistration. Choose child. Select program. Review and update info.
3. In 1-2 weeks, you will receive a school email confirming your child has a spot. If you enrolled a New Child, email the New Child's immunization form as a pdf or picture to katie@mtzb.org or send a copy in your Current Child's bag to school by **March 5th**.
4. **You do NOT need to send in an immunization form for a Returning child UNLESS you have a child in Kindergarten who must email in DPH Form 3300, which you can find on our website.**
5. If you want to change your online payment method, let us know when you use the MyProcare registration. A link will be texted to you based on your registration. Please set up your payment method within 4 days of receiving the link. The registration fee will be deducted **March 5th**. See the Payment Calendar for additional payment dates.
6. Once we receive your child's immunization form for New Children **AND** the Registration fee, your child's spot is saved. (No immunization form is needed for a Returning Child(ren) **UNLESS** your child is going into Kindergarten and must submit the DPH Form 3300, which you can find on our website.)
7. If your child has allergies, complete and email the "Allergy Reaction Plan" to katie@mtzb.org. The form is found on the website.
8. Start your registration! If you have used MyProcare before, go to www.myprocare.com using your email and password. First time users of MyProcare, go HERE.

Failure to send in the Immunization Form and to pay Registration by March 5th will result in your child's spot being released.
