Souled Out Summer Camp - June 1-5, 2026 Laguna Beach Resort

Souled Out is a Christian conference for middle and high school students. It is held at Laguna Beach Christian Retreat on the west end of Panama City Beach, Florida and it focuses on students' relationship with Christ. Morning and evening worship and speakers set the tone for each day. The conference is discipleship oriented, and each student will participate in a D-Group (disciple group) made up of students of their grade and gender. Each D-group is led by college age Discipleship Leaders (D-Leaders) whose focus is on helping students open up and grow closer to Christ. Lots of free time is scheduled each afternoon for individual activities, swimming at the pools or beach, playing basketball, Ultimate Frisbee, volleyball, tournaments, competing in the strong man/woman contest, or just hanging out and relaxing. 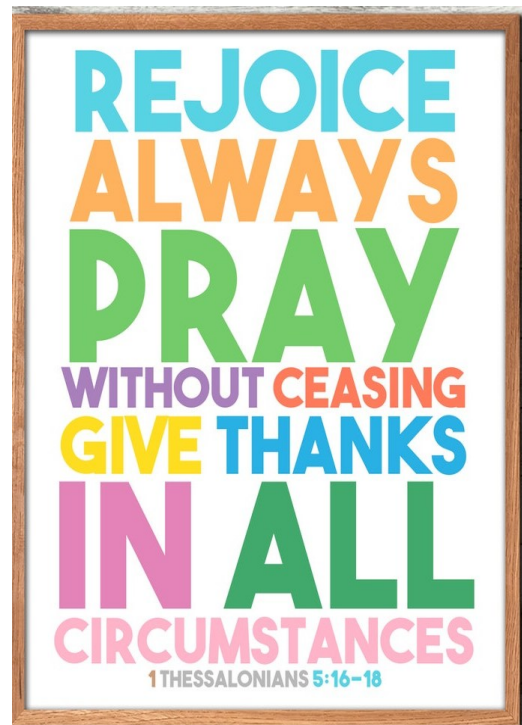
