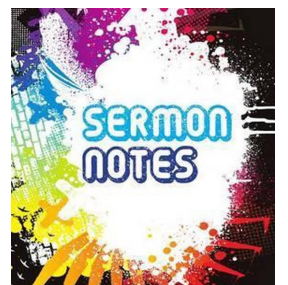
Upward Basketball
