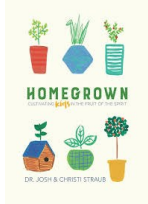
**"Homegrown" - Parenting Study**

**NEW WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY**

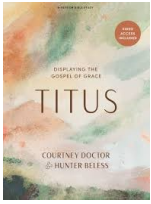
**"Titus" - Women's Bible Study**

**NEW MEN'S BIBLE STUDIES**

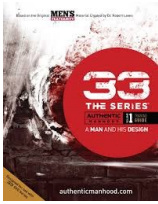
**"33 The Series" - Men's Bible Study**
