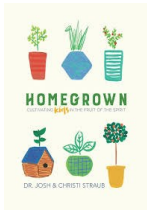
"Homegrown" - Parenting Study

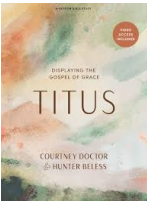
