All women are welcome to join us as learn about a new woman in the Bible each week. These revealing stories of frailties, struggles, brokenness, and victories of real women hold up a mirror to our souls that can help us better understand our own story. **TPM** • Transformation Prayer Ministry will be meeting on the second Saturday of every month from 9-11 am. It is not about managing pain, but resolving the root problem that is the source of our pain. This Holy Spirit lead process will refine your faith and renew your mind, which leads to transformation. You CAN walk in wholeness and healing daily. If you have not attended a TPM class in the past, feel free to join the group as we continue to learn and apply the principles, purposes and process of TPM in our daily lives.

**PRESERVICE PRAYER** • As we desire for God's presence to be encountered by all who enter when we gathering corporately on Sunday mornings, you can join us in creating an atmosphere for the Holy Spirit to move during our pre-service prayer from 8:15-9 am. We will meet in the children's wing prayer room and then split to pray throughout the facility.

# MISSION FOCUS: JEWS FOR JESUS

*"We relentlessly pursue God's plan for the salvation of the Jewish people."*

This mission statement of Jews for Jesus reflects the heart of God for His chosen people as stated by Paul in Romans 10:1: "Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved." They engage the Jewish community with the message of Jesus and to spiritually transform them through the knowledge and love of God. The staff come from diverse Jewish backgrounds, but they have one thing in common: they all believe Yeshua (Jesus) is the Messiah the prophets foretold.



Their mission is to engage with people in conversations about Jesus, teach the Scriptures and disciple new followers of Jesus, equipping new generations of Jewish believers worldwide to serve and live for Jesus. They serve the poor and elderly in places like Ukraine and Russia, minister to Holocaust survivors in their last days of life and provide meals to the homeless, the addicted, and those trapped in prostitution. In these ways, they proclaim the message of hope and help transform lives by the power of the gospel.
