

Romans 1:8-15

The Heart Of Gospel Ministry

- **I. Introduction:** Paul wrote Romans to express his appreciation for them and to say that he desired to come to Rome soon so that he could preach the gospel there.
- II. The Heart Of Gospel Ministry (Rom 1:8-15).
 - A. Paul's Appreciation (v. 8).
 - 1. Paul thanked God for the faith of the Roman believers because they had a strong testimony for Jesus, which he had heard of in Corinth while writing this letter.
 - B. Paul's Petitions (vv. 9-10).
 - 1. Paul wanted to let them know that he was constantly praying for them, so that they might be firmly established and he might finally come to visit them.
 - C. Paul's Intentions (vv. 11-12).
 - 1. Paul loved the Christians in Rome, and wanted them to know that he longed to see them soon, so he could preach the gospel and encourage them.
 - D. Paul's Preparations (v. 13).
 - 1. Paul wanted to come to Rome to preach the gospel, and this letter is meant to lay the groundwork for the salvation he longed to proclaim.
 - E. Paul's Obligations (vv. 14-15).
 - 1. Paul believed that he was indebted to humanity to preach the gospel, since God had commissioned him as an Apostle to the Gentiles.
- **III. Conclusion:** Paul wanted to come to Rome to minister to the believers in the city, but until now, he hadn't had the opportunity to go and strengthen them.

- 6. How did Paul want God to use him? (Rom 1:13) What did Paul mean by obtaining fruit? (v. 13) How is godly character fruit? (Gal 5:22-23) How are converts fruit? (Rom 16:5)
- 7. Why did Paul feel obligated to preach Christ? (Rom 1:14-15) How had God called Paul to be an Apostle? (Acts 9:15; Gal 2:7) How deeply did he feel this calling? (1 Cor 9:16)
- 8. What do we learn about ministry? (Rom 1:8-15) How is prayer essential to ministry? Why is spiritual growth vital? (Matt 28:19-20) Why do we need to preach Christ? (Rom 1:16-17)
